In my Dreaming... Mother Earth quietly whispers of ancient stories and shares her wisdom, so that we can be enlightened and better understand the purpose of our own journey of Dreaming.

These stories are told to me by Ancestors passed, and any similarities between these stories and Dreamtime from other Aboriginal Countries is not meant to cause any cultural disrespect.



These Dreamtime stories are a gift from my Aboriginal Ancestors that are channelled from the universal wisdom from past Caretakers of this land. I am humbled by the stories that were shared with me, and respectfully thank the Ancestors for sharing their dreamtime stories.

I wish to acknowledge the wisdom of Our Aboriginal Elders past, and the courage of our Elders present. Together both past and present Elders guide us with insight and teach us resilience so that we may grow through each generation.

I humbly thank you.

DREAMTIME relates to the stories which encompass our Aboriginal values, beliefs and lore – essentially Dreamtime is our ancient bible which explains our creation and provides us with the guidance of how best to understand and live our lives, whilst being at one with mother earth and father sun.

DREAMING relates to our journey as Aboriginal Peoples and includes the many paths we take during our human existence and includes initiation, ceremony and rites of passage. Our dreaming is about the track on which we travel during our seasons and our different phases of life as Aboriginal men and women.

Option 1

Shuffle the oracle cards and think about what you'd like to learn from your reading. When you've decided what you'd like to know pull one oracle card from the deck and use that card as your guidance for the question you have asked.

Option 2

The second way to read oracles cards is to again shuffle the cards thinking about the questions to which you want answers or guidance. When you are ready take three oracle cards. These represent your past, present and future. Read them in the order you pulled them from the pack.

For a deeper reading you can take 3 oracle cards to represent your past, 4 for the present and 5 oracle cards for your future. To make the oracle card reading spread the cards out in a pyramid shape in front of you, the 3 cards representing the past at the top of the pyramid, the 5 for your future at the bottom. Don't feel bound by the books interpretation. Use your own intuition to decide what each oracle card means. You will certainly develop your own relationship with the cards the more you use them. If your interpretation differs a little from mine, don't worry. Go with what feels right. And what feels right will usually be your own interpretation.





ANCESTRAL STORIES

Back in the dreamtime there lived two families of possums. The families shared the same tree and lived happily together for generations. Both families had small possums who grew up together and shared many adventures – their families would often laugh at how inseparable they were.

One day they decided to go on an adventure and found themselves by the river bank, which was the ground of a cranky crocodile. They both dared each other to go closer to the banks of the river to see if they could see him, and in a blink of an eye the crocodile pounced forth from the river and ate the young possum closest to the water.

The other possum scampered home in a panic to tell the families what had occurred. The other family was so very angry with the young possum, that they blamed his family for the loss of their son. As days and months went by, both families began to squabble and in the end, were never friends again. Consequently all the babies born in the following generations also hated each other, never understanding why they were not allowed to like each other.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Be fair and think clearly about the decision you are about to make. It will have long lasting effects that you may not be able to rectify if you make the wrong choice. Sometimes you have a tendency to want outcomes that are somewhat beyond the scope of what is realistic. Take some time and weigh up all your options and ensure you have all the correct information.



CEREMONIAL RITES

The girl is born and nurtured by the women of the mob. As she grows from a baby to a young girl and into a young woman, the Mothers teach her of her responsibilities to contribute to the running of the clan. As she grows she understands the importance of the wisdom passed down to her from the Mothers, and knows that to become a woman she must first be initiated.

When the right time comes she is fussed over and dressed and lead to the bora ring to become initiated as a woman. During her ceremony she gives up her rights as a child and completes her ceremony as a woman. She will continue to learn the dreaming and dreamtime of the mob, but it is now her responsibility to pass on this wisdom and the stories to the other young children of the mob.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Sometimes it's hard to find the patience to get where you want to go or get what you need. We often blame time as the enemy because it's taking too long; yet time is the very reason we get to where we are going. Everything happens when the timing is right and to force it before then will often end with undesired outcomes. Just wait a bit longer, you're almost there but there is just a bit more information you need to complete the learning of the experience.



CREATION

In the dark of the night a different world exists. It's a night time world that is full of life, yet we just can't see it. At night we go to sleep and wake up to many different things that the world has created overnight, like small ant mounds or the intricate web of a spider that wasn't there the day before.

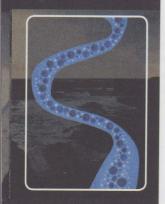
The Universe is always changing and it is in our adaptability to change that we often neglect to see the differences.

Our world continually creates new life and new ideas, each starting from a seed or thought but all having the potential to grow into something worthwhile.

Creation creates itself and we continue to evolve from each creation, growing wiser and stronger with each evolution.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Creation is all around us, yet we never stop to appreciate it. Creation is as simple as a new idea that you recognise as something important to you. You have a really good idea at the moment and you just need to find the courage to see it through. When your idea is given due consideration and you give it a life, it will become one of those moments in time when you remember what a fantastic idea it was. Go on... be game!



DADIRRI

Once there were two mobs and whilst they were neighbours, both mobs always fought with each other. The feuding had been going on for so long that no-one really knew why they were fighting anymore, but still they continued.

One day the wise man of one of the mobs saw in his mind a great rain that would flood the rivers and would drown all the mobs if they stayed where they were. A council of Elders gathered and the information was shared. At first the other mob thought it to be a trick because there was only one area of high ground in the area and that would mean that both mobs would have to share the area and live together.

Eventually after much persuasion both mobs reluctantly moved together to higher ground. In the days that

followed the rain began to fall and did not stop for one whole moon cycle.

During this time the rivers rose quickly and inundated the camps where they had previously lived and washed away any trace that they had ever lived there.

Over the days and weeks that followed, both mobs were grateful that they had been saved from the river. The mob now lived as one and formed a council of Elders to lead them and teach them, and after many generations they finally understood the wisdom of listening.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

In life we find ourselves influenced only by what one person says, and forget that theirs is only one of many stories. Often we need someone brave enough to step up and end a situation that has been dragging on and has lost all meaning and purpose from the original issue. It's your turn to step up to the plate. It may be challenging, but you can end it here and now because they will listen to you.



DEEP LISTENING

The bush has become quiet. No noise at all. The birds have flown away and the animals have run to safety. Suddenly the wind picks up and there is a smell of smoke in the air. The smoke becomes thick and the surrounding temperature rises quickly - then the bush explodes into fire.

The fire consumes everything in its path and as it passes it leaves the bush scorched and burnt - void of life. Then slowly the smoke disappears and the burnt trees and ground begins to cool. Silence returns as if in respect and anticipation for the new landscape which will begin to be created.

The silence remains for many months, then as the new leaves begin to shoot forth from the once burnt trees, life slowly begins to return to the bush. As the food begins to

grow again the animals return, and the bush is different to when they escaped the flames. The animals find new homes to live in and quickly adapt to their new surroundings.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

You may be feeling desolate and displaced right now. You have been through a really rough time and may wonder if there is an end to it all. There is, and it will be here soon. Just give yourself a bit more time to grieve the loss, as your heart needs time to heal before it can grow from this experience. In the next week you will just wake up and realise that things have gotten better and your heart has begun to heal.



DREAMING

Once, many generations ago, a young girl struggled to sleep. Each time she slept she dreamt of things – sometimes good and sometimes bad. She would talk only to her grandmother about her dreams for fear of what the rest of the mob may think of her.

During one particularly hot summer the rain did not come and the water holes were drying up. Although this mob were good hunters and knew their country well, they could not find any water. One night as the water was all but gone, the girl dreamt of water hidden just below the surface of the ground which was in plentiful supply. She woke the next morning to tell her grandmother of her dream.

Together the young girl and grandmother set out from camp early that morning and walked through the land that

they had known for hundreds of generations. They came across the large rock that the young girl had dreamt about the night before and when they began to dig the sand around it, water began to trickle to the surface and within a short time they were sitting in water waist deep.

They returned to their camp and explained how they had found the bountiful water supply. The mob were amazed that they had walked past that very same spot many times before in search of water and they had never known it existed.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

You are in a cycle where your dreams are providing you with the answers to the issue at hand. Begin to take notice of your dreams as they are often prophetic. Your dreams are giving you clear messages at the moment, but you still resist because you are having trouble trusting yourself and your decisions. Trusting in this one decision will turn the tides for you.



DREAMTIME LEARNING

Once when the land was still being created there was a giant serpent, and as he weaved his way through the land his body would leave deep gullies deep in the earth. Some of the animals didn't like the serpent as there were times that he would change the shape of the land, which meant they would have to find new ways in which to survive.

On one occasion as the serpent disturbed the water in a shallow stream the fish became stranded on the banks of mud. As fear overcame the fish they took their first breath of air, and realised that they were able to breathe air like the other land animals. As the heat of the day began to dry their bodies, one by one they started to dig themselves into the cool mud.

Now every year when the dry season comes and the wetlands begin to dry up, the lung fish begin to breathe air and dig themselves deep into the mud until the wet season returns and they can again return to their beloved water home.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Your ability to be flexible and to "go with the flow" is one of your strong points, however sometimes flexibility can provide us with too many choices. You have a short attention span and are too willing to change tactics half way through the game, but this is a time to just make a decision and stick with it. No changing the game plan this time – follow it through and you will attain your victory.



EARTH MOTHER

Before the Dreamtime existed the world was dark and cold. The plants were small and barely grew in the damp dark soil. The few animals that existed burrowed underground where they could huddle together for warmth.

One day a lizard who was so tired of always being cold ventured above ground to look for a warmer place to live. He walked for days and days then stumbled upon a small yellow flower that had somehow managed to thrive in the dark cold conditions.

The lizard had never seen a flower before and was so amazed at its colour and beauty that he sat staring at it for days. For days he wished and wished that the other animals who lived beneath the ground could see the beauty of the flower.

After days of watching the flower he become so exhausted he fell asleep. Whilst the lizard slept, a feeling of warmth began to generate throughout his body and when he opened his eyes the darkness he had always known had disappeared. The world was warm and bright, and all around him he could see everything so clearly. The lizard looked up toward the bright blue sky and found the source of the warmth and light- the sun had been born.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

This is a time when things are feeling dark and ominous, and it's just too hard to see beyond the depths of your darkness. Don't fear the dark because dawn always follows close behind. Your darkness is about to end; prepare yourself for seeing things in the new light of a new day. Each dawn is the opportunity to begin again...

So, what wonderful things are you going to create?

EMOTIONAL EXHAUSTION

In the dreamtime the Koala walked on the ground. It was a hard life for the Koala as he would sometimes have to walk for days to find his food as the eucalypt leaves he usually ate grew high in the trees and getting food was often difficult, as he couldn't reach them.

One day he was sitting at the bottom of the tree tired and hungry when a goanna walked past and stopped to see why the Koala was upset. The goanna laughed and asked the Koala if he could see his claws, which the Koala proudly showed the goanna. The goanna asked why the Koala didn't just climb up the tree and get his food.

The Koala said he didn't know how to climb, so the goanna spent the day teaching the Koala to climb. By the end of the day the Koala was an expert climber and sat in the top of the tree eating till his tummy was so full, that all

he could do was go to sleep. When all the other Koalas saw him at the top of the tree eating and sleeping all day they followed his example. From this day on, this became the Koala's new way of life.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

It may be feeling like with every step forward you take two steps back. Sometimes our impatience prevents us from seeing that our very actions are what is setting us back. Just re-evaluated the situation for a moment and reset your goals, because what you're trying to achieve will still be there when you find your feet, and then things will move forward very quickly.



FATHER OF THE SKY

One day an emu and a kangaroo were sitting around talking and arguing over which of them was the fastest. After some heated discussion they both decided that a race would be the best way to settle the argument. As they looked out to the distant desert, they decided that the finish line would be at the edge of the desert where the red dirt met with the blue sky.

On the count of three they were both off and running. They ran and ran and ran, both keeping up with each other, but as fast as they ran, they felt like the finish line wasn't getting any closer.

Eventually the emu and the kangaroo both fell to the ground exhausted, and huffing and puffing from their very long run. As they lay on the ground panting looking up into the sky, they wondered why they couldn't reach the

finish line and yet had run so far. As they lay there they watched the clouds move through the sky and realised that Father Sky who surrounded them, had no beginning and no end – he was infinite, and there was no finish line. They both laughed and laughed at their stupidity and decided that the race was a fiel

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Sometimes things feel as though they are out of your reach and that no matter what you do you just can't quite get there. Sometimes it's because it is impossible, yet you are unwilling to accept the reality of this. Change your way of thinking and look at things in a different light – this may be a situation you cannot change, but it does not mean failure – just adaptation.



HEALING JOURNEY

The little bush bee was an industrious little fellow. He flittered around constantly and as soon as he rested for a moment he would hurry back to work collecting more honey. All the other bees wished they could be as resourceful as him because he was always finding new places to collect his honey.

One day all the bees were resting and discussing the dangers of a new yellow flower they had found which could make them sick. The busy bee had already gone back to work and missed the conversation as he was in a hurry to collect more honey.

Late that evening he returned to the other bees, but they could see that he was unwell. After some prompting they discovered that the busy bee had indeed found the new yellow flower that they had discussed earlier during their rest time.

The little bee became very sick, and during his recovery was unable to work. He spent this time listening to the other

bees and discovering that if you stopped and listen to others, there is a lot to learn.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

The constant chatter in your head must be exhausting... never a moment of peace for you! The chatter is constant because you don't take time to listen to it, so it has to keep repeating itself until you listen... listen to the chatter then it will go away- it's that simple. You will then start to find the peace and quiet you have been searching for.



HIDDEN LEARNING

After three months of fiercely defending her eggs, the mother crocodile begins to see movement under the mound of sand which indicates that her babies are being born. She eagerly waits for them to emerge from their eggs and welcomes each of them into the world.

She gently takes each baby to the water and bids them goodbye, knowing they will not see each other again. The last baby she takes to the water is frail and begs his mum not to let him go, because he wants to grow up with her. The mummy crocodile explains that he has to go and make it on his own and have all the adventures of growing up that all the other crocodiles have. Reluctantly he swims away calling to her that he will come back to visit her when he is grown up.

As he grows up he has many experiences and learns many lessons, but there is rarely a time when he doesn't miss his mum, and longs to find her again and tell her about his life.

One day, many years later, he becomes a dad himself. As his babies hatch and are taken gently to the water by their mum, he finally understands the importance of letting his babies have their own experiences. He tells them he will miss them, but lets them go on their own journey.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Letting go of things you hold close is really hard sometimes, but often the most damage is caused because you can't let it go. Take a leap of faith and know that by letting go, you are actually assisting something/someone else to grow and experience life for themselves. Everyone's journey is individual and we have little power over what is best for them.



INNER GRIEF

These are the times of sadness and loss where simply the colour of our skin determines our future. The mother watches intently as her children play close to the humpy where she can see them, but for a few moments she is distracted. After that short time when her attention is returned to the children, she notices a plume of dust and then a black car driving up the dirt road which quickly pulls up close to her children. As she screams at the children to run, she knows in her heart they do not have enough time to get away.

She is hysterical as she begs the welfare people not to take her brown skinned babies, but they do. She collapses to the ground where she will stay, until her children are returned to her. Over the years the mothers black hair turns grey and years of weather chisels her features, yet she maintains her watch – never venturing far from this spot and never seeing her children again.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Your heart has taken a battering and with every breath you take, it physically hurts. You have no choices in this situation, so the only way forward is to begin your own healing journey. Learn to forgive yourself and know that this forgiveness will begin to heal your heart and yourself esteem will slowly begin to build. It will be a slow process but day by day you will get through this, and you will look back in a few weeks and recognise the massive journey you have undertaken.



INNER QUIET

Back in the beginning of time there was a huge rock in the middle of the desert. The rock was born from the ground over many millions of years, and during this time the sun and the rain had sculptured amazing shapes into him, and if you looked closely, you could see the caves and shelters that had been forged through the millenniums.

In the desert where the rock lived, the days were burning hot and nights were freezing cold. He liked the heat during the day, but he often wished he could also be warm during the cold desert nights. As the rock had no voice, he could only watch as the plants began to grow, then animals started to evolve then eventually people were born into this land.

He watched for thousands of years as people passed him by. Then one day a young boy whose family had become sick on their walk-a-bout came to the rock in search of shelter. After a short time the young boy found a small hole in the rock and after exploring it further found a cave which could offer his family the hope of survival.

From that day onwards, the family would build a fire deep inside the cave to keep themselves warm, never knowing that the warmth from their fire was keeping the rock warm at night from the cold desert.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Look more closely at what is happening around you, as you seem to have a limited view of what the situation is really about. Spend some time investigating your concerns because a whole new horizon will appear before you once you start looking more closely. You will begin to understand that the wonderful choices you have before you - were always there, you just couldn't see them.



INSIGHTFUL REVELATIONS

Once during the Dreamtime the emus had short legs. Even though the emu was a bird, he couldn't fly and at best, could only waddle at a slow pace. The worst thing of all was that the good food was way above his head and he only ever got to eat the food at the bottom of the bushes, and if he was lucky he might get the scraps that fall from the taller birds.

One day the emus got together to discuss how difficult their lives were being at the bottom of the food chain. They no longer wanted to live this way so decided that they would all gather and pray to the great Creator and ask for long legs.

They prayed all night until they eventually fell asleep exhausted and disappointed because nothing had happened.

As the first rays of sunlight broke into the sky the first emu woke to find he had long legs. He woke all the others who were so excited that they took off running a hundred miles an hour! Now the emus run faster than all the other bush animals and never have to eat scraps from the ground again.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Our heads are full of ideas, but it's the idea within the idea that gives us the most satisfaction – you know, the idea that grows from a singular thought into a reality, and looks nothing like the original idea, but is better than that first idea? You need to consider your ideas as having the potential to create amazing changes in your life.



INTERNAL STRENGTH

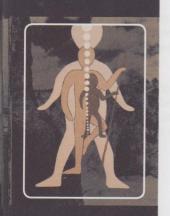
There was a baby wombat who often dawdled behind, always being distracted by one thing or another. One day as usual he was slowly meandering his way through the bush, not making much effort to keep up with his mum, when a strong wind came and blew down a massive tree which blocked his way and separated him from his mother.

He cried for his mother but all they could do was yell across the large expanse of the tree which separated them from each other. The little wombat was so determined that he began to dig – he was good at digging and knew this was his only way of getting to his mum.

As fast as he would dig big rocks would block his way, however through his determination he would just start digging in a different direction. For days he dug still calling to his mother to make sure she hadn't left him. Eventually he dug an entire tunnel and was reunited with his mother on the other side. From this day forward he no longer dawdled and always kept his mum in sight.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Find your inner strength – believe in yourself and work through the situation. Sometimes you do not realise how much power you have and if you are not careful you can end up destroying everything in your path. Look at alternatives around this issue - they are there if you just look at other ways to solve the problem.



MEN'S BUSINESS

There was a young boy who was eager to grow up, but the Men of the mob said he was still too young to be educated in Men's business and he had to just be patient and his time would come. He would follow the men every chance he got and was always listening in when the men were talking their business.

One day when he was secretly following the men he got separated from the mob and found himself lost and wandering in the bush. No matter how hard he tried to find his way back he found himself even more lost. The young boy had learnt enough from the men that he was able to feed himself and find shelter.

Many years later on walk-a-bout, he came across his mob and was reunited with his family. They were very proud of the young man and the skills he had learnt looking after himself in the bush for many seasons. The wise man of the mob called him aside one day and gave him the responsibility of teaching all the young fellows in the mob the bush skills they needed to care for themselves and their families.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

It's time to grow up and be mature. The childish tantrums you have at times only ensure you will be treated as a child. You have to make a decision to be either the child or the adult in the situation. If you take on the role of the adult, you also need to assume the responsibilities of an adult as well. It's not hard, it's just scary!



MOON PHASES

Once, a long time ago under the light of a full moon, an echidna was foraging for food, and a small wallaby caught his attention. The echidna waddled up to the wallaby and began talking with him, and they became instant friends. They had so much fun that night that when the morning came and they had to return to their homes they parted with sorrow in their hearts.

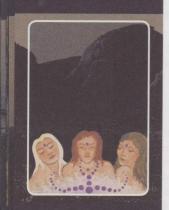
The next night the wallaby returned to find his friend, however after waiting all night the echidna did not come back. Every night for the next month he returned, as the wallaby refused to give up on the thought of never seeing his friend again.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Look to the cycles in your life to get a better understanding of what your journey looks like, learn from the lows and celebrate the highs, then find the middle ground – focusing too much on either will often create chaos in your life.



MOTHER NATURE'S BALANCE

In the bush another summer comes, bringing with it oppressive heat and little rain, but the plants know that they just have to survive the heat for a few weeks longer until the rain arrives and replenishes their strength and gives them vitality to survive another summer.

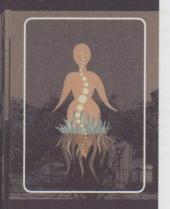
But this year when the rain comes, it doesn't stay for long, and there is not enough time to fully recover from the long hot summer they have just endured. The summer comes again quickly and stays for longer, with even less rain than the year before. The ground is cracked and scorched and many of the less resilient plants are dying. This cycle repeats itself for seven summers, with each summer bringing less and less rain than the previous year.

Eventually the drought breaks and rain comes in abundance. The rain brings with it new plants that have

never grown in the bush before, creating food for different types of animals that have not inhabited this bush for many years. Before long, the birth and creation of different animals and plants makes the bush a wonderland of the precious sounds of life.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

You need to find balance between work and life. You have got yourself believing that neither can survive without you... You are wrong! It's you who feels you can't survive without them. Everyone will benefit if you step away and allow them to step up, because at that time you enable them to remain stuck because you won't let them have a go. They may not do it as well as you but they won't mess up either.



PATIENCE

When the wind was created, he loved his ability to fly around the bush listening to all the animals' voices in the bush. After some time of hearing all the voices he began to feel upset with the nasty things that the animals would say about each other. He moved around from the bush to the desert and to the ocean, but wherever he went it was the same – more animals saying cruel things to each other.

After returning to the desert he realised that nothing would ever change. This made him very mad and in his anger he started to turn round in circles, eventually beginning to spin wildly, with the dust being thrown into the air and the dirt and rocks from the ground scattering in all directions.

After a while he got tired and just stopped spinning. In his exhaustion he realised that he was no longer angry and that he felt good from this. Over time the wind became to accept that when he got upset, he would simply spin himself round and round until all his anger and energy had been spent, then he would just stop and move onto until the next time he became upset.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Life feels out of control right now and it's hard to see the light through the dust. You continually turn yourself inside out trying to find ways to deal with this situation. You are so focused on this situation that you don't realise that sometimes it's not your situation to control. Hand this situation over to the person who is truly in control of it and just simply step back.



PEACE

In the bush the wise woman is surrounded by her family as she exhales her last breath, and peacefully passes into the next world. She is much loved and respected by her mob and the word goes out that she has passed.

There is no urgency to bury the body, as this is a process that takes time. The passing of the body should not be rushed and we allow the spirit to pass in its own time. We gather around to pay our respects to the wise woman, and mobs gather on the outskirts in solemn silence till the right time comes and they are invited in. When the right people are present, together we paint the body and prepare for ceremony. After the ceremony the mobs are left with a sense of deep peace as they return to their countries, having paid their final respects to the wise woman.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Take time out to find the peace that is so elusive for you right now. Peace is sometimes elusive as the harder we try to make time for it, the further away it gets. Wait until everything lines up, take a breath and in that breath find the peace that is within the very breath itself. Breathe through these difficult times, still your mind and peace will find you.



PREPARATION

A long time ago our mobs would travel our country in search of food and shelter for each different season. During these times we would pass each other on our dreaming tracks and gather together to celebrate the birth of the new, and the passing of the old.

When our people would pass into the next world, we would take time to address our Sorry Business. There was no time limit to grieve - just an instinctual "knowing" when it was time to move on.

Our "wise ones" knew that if we ran from our grief that it would eventually catch up to us, so we were taught to wait and respect our mourning process and to celebrate life when the timing was right.

We were taught to be patient during our mourning process, and that if we honoured the time it took to

undertake our Sorry Business, then we would not be chased by spirits along our future journeys.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Sometimes we lose so much and so often, there is no time to stop and grieve. Often when we do stop to think about our losses we can become so overwhelmed with the grief associated with our own Sorry Business. Our Wise Ones tell us if we don't deal with our grief, the ghosts of the past will keep following us until we set them free. When we set them free we will also be setting ourselves free. It's hard work, but it's got to be done.



QUIET STILLNESS

During the dry season, the water in the stream lazily meanders it way down the gentle slope through many crooks and turns, eventually making its way to the edge of the waterfall. As it reaches the edge it gently washes over the rocks and drifts down as fine mist till it reaches the bottom of the gully where it lands below on the bush vegetation to provide it with sustenance and life.

For nine months of the year the stream flows at a slow pace. The dry heat of the day builds strong banks and creates structure for the stream, however during the long hot days trees and branches fall into the gentle stream and sometimes block its flow or change its direction.

For three months of the year, the wet season arrives and brings continuous rain which floods the stream and transforms it into a raging torrent. As the water builds and rushes by, it begins to clear away the debris which may have blocked its course during the dry season.

When the dry season returns the stream is back to its original flow and the debris from the past has been washed away leaving beautiful rich soil for new regrowth which will strengthen the banks of the stream for the next wet season.

DREAMTIME MESSAGE

Change is not a bad thing. Weigh up all the pros and cons and find the courage to make a commitment – one way or the other. Both options are good, so you can't lose. You can always return to the way it was before, but it may be nice to experience something different for a while. Things may not go smoothly at first, however they will find their own natural course and you will just flow with the new way of doing things.



REBIRTH

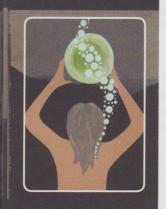

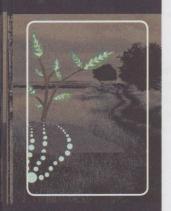

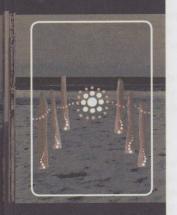
As the little seed emerged from the earth it became a small but strong stem, and then as it was no longer

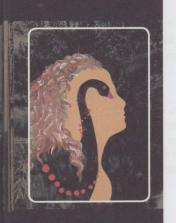

The emu went in search of the bush plums and when he found the bountiful tree, was delighted by the amount of

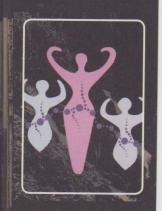
beautiful plums he would be able to have all to himself. He swallowed his first plum and to his horror the plum got stuck in this throat.

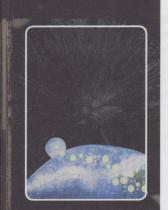

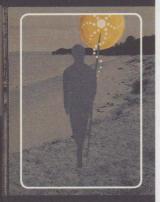

SPIRIT CONNECTION

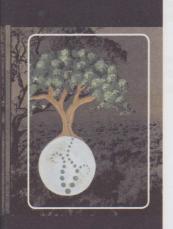

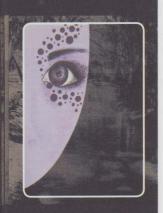
THIRSTY EARTH

WOMEN'S WISDOM

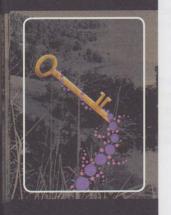

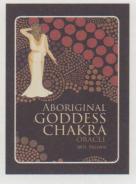

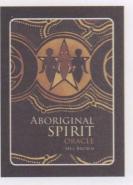
